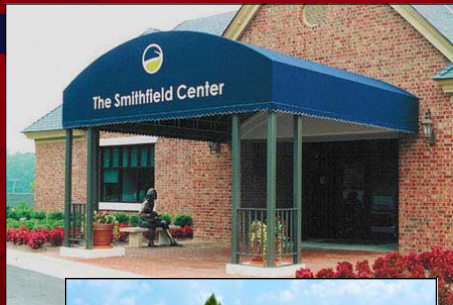

## smithfield isle of wight — VIRGINIA —

When you step onto Main Street in downtown Smithfield you step into a time when people acknowledged each other by name. We're proud to be the #1 day-trip destination from Williamsburg! Our arts and culture scene, historic attractions, specialty shops, places to relax by the rivers, unique accommodations and eateries make Smithfield & Isle of Wight one of Virginia's treasures.

**hams** Smithfield is known as the "Ham Capital of the World." Members of the English monarchy had standing orders for Smithfield's famous hams prior to the Revolution. Smithfield Foods, headquartered here, is a Fortune 500 company.

**history** Isle of Wight was one of the eight original shires in Virginia, discovered by Captain John Smith and other early settlers. The Town of Smithfield, nestled along the banks of the Pagan River, is home to over 50 historic homes featuring Colonial, Federal and Victorian architecture - some of which have been transformed into museums, restaurants and specialty shops.

**hospitality** Enjoy B&B's, inns, and other lodgings that offer exceptional views of our waterways and historic district. Our restaurants offer the freshest local seafood and succulent locally produced pork and ham. And don't forget to take advantage of all the outdoor opportunities in the area, such as the brand new Windsor Castle Park, a riverside park located right in the heart of Historic Smithfield, offering miles of woodland trails, picnic areas, a kayak/canoe launch, scenic overlooks, a dog park, fishing pier and a mountain bike path.

**heart** With five galleries in the Historic District, Smithfield is one of Tidewater's favorite arts destinations! The Arts Center @ 319 exhibits the works of local and regional artists, while hosting eight resident artists. Take in a show at the Smithfield Little Theatre or enjoy live music during our Friday Night Summer Concerts or several other stellar concert series. Special events such as SmARTs (*Smithfield Monthly Arts Stroll*), a farmers market, county fair and festivals abound!
